

A Warranty Card containing the following information is included with each trailer. The DEALER is responsible for filling out the warranty card for the customer and returning it to the factory to register the customer's warranty.

Behnke Enterprises, Inc. Warranty

Behnke Enterprises, Inc. (the "company") warrants each new trailer to the original owner to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of one (1) year, except as herein limited, from date of purchase. The obligation of this Warranty shall be limited to repairing or replacing any part or parts which, in the opinion of the Company, shall be proved defective in materials or workmanship under normal use and service during the one-year-period beginning with the date of purchase. The trailer finish is warranted for a period of 120 days.

This warranty does not cover winches, lights, couplers, brakes, tongue jacks, springs and tires or wheels. This warranty also excludes all other component parts. Specifically, and without limitation, Company provides no warranty, express or implied, of any type related to the tires, brakes or wheel bearings of any trailer.

The provisions of this warranty shall not apply to any product which is found to have been modified or altered in any way nor shall the warranty apply to any defect or malfunction caused by damage, unreasonable use, failure to provide reasonable and necessary maintenance, an act of God or nature, or any other cause other than a defect in materials or workmanship.

This warranty does not cover damage caused by overloading the trailer beyond stated capacities, or use of improperly installed weight distribution hitches in conjunction with hydraulic surge brakes, damage due to highly corrosive conditions, or a trailer exposed to rust.

It is understood and agreed that Company's liability whether in contract, in tort, under any warranty, in negligence or otherwise shall not exceed the return of the amount of the purchase price paid by the purchaser and under no circumstances shall Company, as seller, be liable for special, indirect or consequential damages. The price stated for the equipment is a consideration in limiting seller's liability. No action, regardless of form, arising out of the transactions under the agreement between Company and buyer may be brought by buyer more than one year after the date of purchase as defined above.

Limitations and Exclusions

This Warranty shall not extend to:

1. Any trailer in which Behnke Enterprises, Inc. has not received the warranty registration card.
2. Equipment which has been modified, repaired, or altered in any way without written consent of Behnke Enterprises, Inc.
3. Unreasonable use, including failure to provide reasonable and necessary maintenance.
4. Equipment such as, tires, axles, axle assemblies, suspension components or other equipment warranted separately by the manufacturer of the components.

Your Behnke Enterprises, Inc. dealer from whom you purchased your trailer is responsible for submitting your warranty with the manufacturer. Please cooperate with your dealer in completing all information on the attached warranty card.

Proper and regular maintenance of your trailer is required to insure longer use. We suggest you check the following:

1. Check lugnuts every 50 and 200 miles as loosening may occur.
2. Manually adjust brakes after 200 miles and every 3,000 miles thereafter.
3. Re-grease and adjust bearings once a year.
4. Check electrical connections regularly.
5. Use correct ball size for hitch.
6. Maintain fluid levels.
7. Evenly distribute load.
8. Proper tire pressure.
